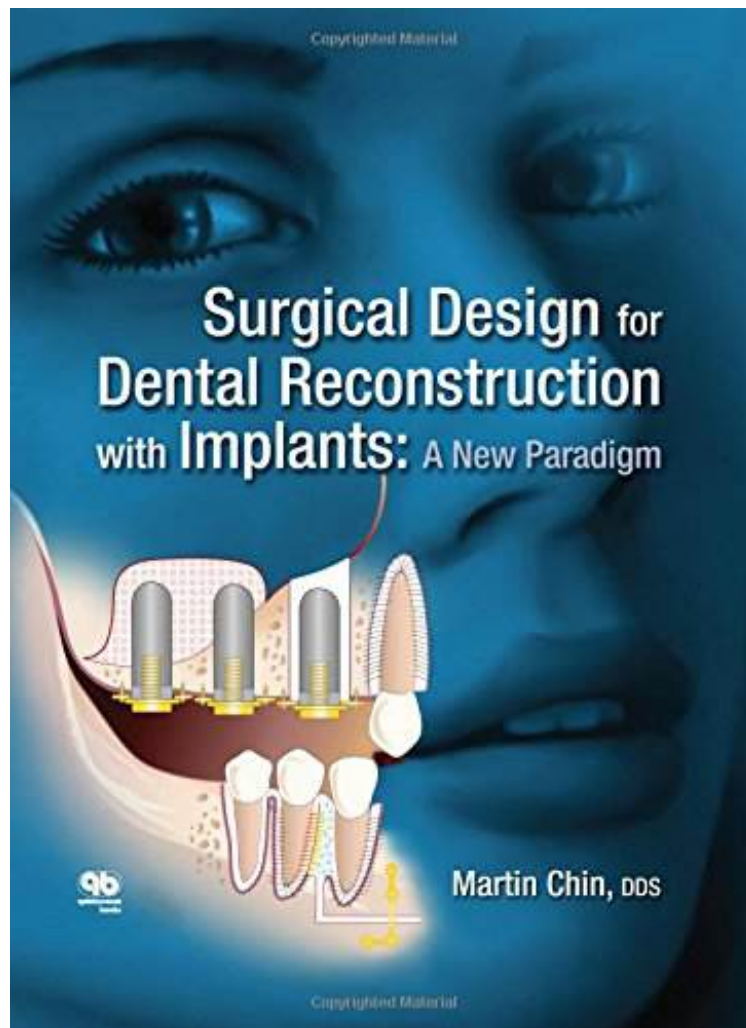


Surgical Design for Dental Reconstruction with Implants: A New Paradigm
